

Program for the 1st Physical Meeting of FutureArcticLives March 2022

The meeting and workshop will focus on concretizing project activities, identifying cross-project collaboration options, and producing draft outlines for these products. Given the focus on actual output, preparation is required.

Preconditions: Taking departure in the joint meeting minutes of November 23rd 2021, each work package or activity – as relevant – must submit:

- Research plans describing the research activities that have been and are to be undertaken - the format can be simply an outline of the expected publications (for example including draft objectives, research questions (hypothesis to be tested if relevant), methods and expected outcomes, including scientific peer-reviewed publications (tentative titles and outlines are fine at this stage).
- A motivated wish list of data, information, connections, methodological, analytical or interpretative assistance requested from other work packages or partners for project activities. This does not need to be restricted to what is generated through the project or necessarily be entirely realistic but will serve as a starting point for becoming specific during the meeting.
- A draft outline of publications for partners discussing collaboration across the project and with external projects/agents not described in the application (some of these may be developed as a result of the meeting).

These must be circulated before the meeting no later than Monday, March 7th to enable other partners to read and contemplate them before the meeting. The overall objective is to identify and highlight opportunities for collaboration across the project and with external actors. Work package leaders will coordinate.
